- WJF logo polo shirt (Royal Blue Pre-K - 7th grades, Navy Blue 8th grade)
- Khaki pants (Pants ONLY – ALL grades. No shorts, skirts, skorts, or joggers allowed. No elastic hems.
- Outerwear must be solid blue or black (WJF Logo only, no stripes, words, etc...).
- Solid color jackets, sweaters, and sweatshirts are allowed (no hoodies 6th – 8th grades).
- Shoes must be **SOLID BLACK**. Shoe strings, soles, stitching, and logos should be all black.
- ALL students must wear a solid black belt.
- Black or white socks Visible undershirts must be white.
